



COMMUNITY GRANTS

GRANT GUIDELINES

We expect to make grants in areas such as education, affordable housing, food security, health, arts, and human services, but grants are not limited to those categories. Organizations must serve the city of White Plains or Westchester as a whole.

Grants will be made only to legally authorized 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations.

There are no minimum or maximum limits to the size of grants, but we expect the average grant per organization to range from \$5,000-10,000 per year. Some grants may be renewed, but grant renewals are not automatic.

Grants are made at the discretion of The Pamplemousse Project, with input from a Customer Advisory Board.

Organizations that discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, veteran status, genetic information, sex, or age (within statutory limits), or any other legally prohibited basis will not be eligible for funding. Religious organizations that benefit the overall community without supporting any specific doctrine are eligible to apply. Local sports teams or booster clubs are not eligible.

We reserve the right to audit the financial records of organizations that apply for or receive grants. Your application is your consent to such an audit, both during the application process and after a grant has been made.
